This 3-day instructor course brings the new phases of technology for police sidearms. Optic systems have been part of the police rifle family for many years. It is now, that the optics are growing in the use by many police agencies nationwide. They are one of the most effective tools available to law enforcement officers as it allows for officers to work threat identification faster with both eyes open. For us, we have always preached the concept of being able to "see your threat fully" without having specific eyes closed and once the basic mastered skills are applied, officers will be able to threat assess subjects much clearer. Keeping the threat in focus is one of the key areas of use of force analysis.



Topics will include but not limited to:

- Instructor familiarization of assorted red dot optics systems that are used in the field
- Firearms instructor development of teaching students the value of increased accuracy once the red dot optic systems become more familiar to end-users
- Understanding the importance of grip, presentation and how it can make shooter more efficient if skills are applied properly
- Showing the differences in use of iron sights vs. red dot optics systems and being to apply instructor knowledge to all end users
- Teaching end-users the importance of shooting with both eyes open and understanding the great field of view
- Knowing current state specific requirements of the use of red dot optics on handguns and other supplemental tools to include co-witness of optics and the dispelling the theory of "remove the irons and just use optics" mentality
- The importance of Low-Light tactical firearms basics and knowing how the eyes work with optics in multiple environments and not just during normal lighting
- Sample policies and showing how to incorporate them into your current firearms policies
- Multiple instructor skill drills to provide solid tactical basics using red dot optics
- Understanding that red dot optics do not replace basic and proper shooting fundamentals

Required Equipment: Service handgun (Optic mounted preferred) with at least 3 magazines, duty holster, weapon light, flashlight and duty belt, 800 rounds of handgun ammunition, hearing and eye protection, department training uniform, firearms cleaning kit, rain gear, ball cap. Note topic covered will also be good for rifle optics
